General Rules and Regulations

Please read and initial on the following rules and regulations.

1. ___ Command Functions may reserve up to 120 days in advance. 90 days for all other patrons.
2. ___ Reservations may be made between the times of 0900 - 2100.
3. ___ Sponsor is responsible for the supervision, safety, security, and clean-up of reserved area. A signed copy of this form or reservation email shall remain with the Sponsor until the completion of the reservation.
4. ___ Breaker's Beach - The Least Tern and Snowy Plover beach nesting season is mid-March to mid-September. Blue stakes mark the restricted areas. Patrons shall stay clear of all restricted areas.
5. ___ Groups expecting over 140 people must reserve Heritage Park, CISM Field or Turner Field. If no reservation is scheduled, the parks are open for free use, no reservation will be issued.
6. ___ Gator Beach: **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. THERE ARE NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY.** Breakers Beach: **LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY ONLY DURING SUMMER MONTHS.**
7. ___ No glassware allowed on any beach, park or open area.
8. ___ Fires and open cooking flames are permitted only in the designated fire pits and cooking areas.
9. ___ Dispose of all charcoal from BBQ grills to the hot coals bins provided. DO NOT leave any fire unattended. Extinguish only by methods while not creating unsafe conditions for other beach goers. Do not bury your fire in the sand.
10. ___ One sponsor may only reserve one cabana per visit. Please see below for capacities not to be exceeded.
 - Breakers/Gator Beach Cabanas: 35 per cabana. Max group size 140
 - Heritage Park: 75 min; 600 max
 - CISM Field: 300 max
 - Turner Field & Pavilion: (75 max, under pavilion) Total group size: 450 max.
11. ___ Sponsor certifies that guest's park in authorized areas. Navy Lodge parking is for overnight guests only.
12. ___ Commands may reserve more than one cabana for a Command sponsored event. A command Endorsement letter is required. Commands will be kept in the same grouping (i.e.: 1-3; 4-7; 8-11), or adjacent at NAB.
13. ___ Dogs (service dogs excepted) and other pets are not allowed at the beach, park or vicinity.
14. ___ Outside catering companies, or any organization, are not authorized to bring or serve food on base.
15. ___ Wedding ceremonies and/or receptions are not allowed on the beach sand, cabana, park, or green space. Wedding must be coordinated with MWR Island Club Catering Office (545-9566 / 9199).
16. ___ If present, alcohol will be consumed in a responsible manner. The sponsor listed on this reservation assumes responsibility for any alcohol consumed within the limits of this reservation. NO GLASS containers
17. ___ The sponsor is responsible to abide by base access requirements. NBC base access phone number 619-545-7413/7412. Email to request the base access form and instruction: NBC_ACCESS@navy.mil
18. ___ Every effort will be made to reserve requested cabanas/space, however NBC (MWR) reserves the right to move reservations based on the need, parking requirements, operational requirements, etc. Every amount of notice possible will be used; however, 'no notice' may also occur in extenuating circumstance. Patrons will be required to comply or will be forced to forfeit reservations.
19. ___ Camping is not allowed at any facility at Naval Base Coronado.
20. ___ The Sponsor understand and acknowledges that the NBC Commanding Officer, or his appointed representative, retains the right to remove anyone from the facility he/she feels is in violation of Federal, State, or Local laws or is involved in any act deemed disruptive to the US Navy's policy of good order and discipline. In the event the group is found to be conducting itself in an objectionable manner, Sponsor shall agree to remove, or have removed said individual(s).
21. ___ Other rules and regulations are posted at each facility. Please read and heed.
